

FRENSHAM POND SAILING CLUB
NOTICE OF RACE
RS Tera Open Meeting Sunday 19th September 2021

- 1) **Organising Authority:** The organising authority is Frensham Pond Sailing Club.
- 2) **Venue:** Frensham Pond Sailing Club, Pond Lane, Churt, Surrey, GU10 2QA.
Races will be sailed on Frensham Great Pond.
- 3) **Rules:** The meeting will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024, the prescriptions of the RYA and the RS Tera Class Rules except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 4) **Eligibility:** Eligible boats are RS Teras with either the Pro or Sport rig. Helms must be insured for third party liabilities of at least £3,000,000.
- 5) **Entry:** Entry will be by online form only using the form available from the Official Online Event Page. Payment will also be online only and must be made at the same time as entry. There is a limit to the number of boats that can enter (50) and once this number is reached subsequent entries may be added to a waiting list.
- 6) **Entry Fee:** The entry fee is £20 per boat (to be paid online only).
- 7) **Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be available from the Online Event Page and the Frensham Pond Sailing Club Website only.
- 8) **Schedule:**

Briefing	10.30
First Warning Signal (morning):	10:55
Lunch break ashore:	From approximately 13.00

It is intended to run a 4-race series during which there will be a break ashore for lunch. Races will be approximately 40 minutes duration for the leading boats. The Race Officer may vary the number and duration of races at his/her discretion.

Provided that there are at least 5 entries for each rig then there will be separate starts for Pro and Sport fleets and results will be calculated separately; otherwise a combined series will be held.

Any changes to the schedule will be posted on the Official Online Event Page at least 30 minutes beforehand.

- 9) **Courses:** Courses will be explained during the briefing and displayed on the Committee Boat.
- 10) **Scoring:** RRS Appendix A – Low Point Scoring System will be used. One race will constitute a series. If less than three races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Otherwise her series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11) **Support Boats:** No support boats other than those owned and operated by FPSC are allowed to launch on Frensham Great Pond.
- 12) **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries.
- 13) **Catering:** Lunch for competitors is included and will be served around 13.00. Hotdogs will be served to competitors at the end of racing.
- 14) **Dogs:** Are welcome but they must be kept on a lead at all times when not in a vehicle and are not allowed in the Clubhouse (guide dogs excepted). Owners must remove and dispose of any fouling.
